SCHOLARSHIP *full participation only

- ASEAN Students and Students with Disabilities**
Students from ASEAN Countries and students with disabilities will be eligible to apply for a limited number of scholarships on a competitive basis for 20 students.
- Students with Disabilities**
Other students with disabilities who have not received full scholarships will be eligible for 50% of the course fee.
- Non-ASEAN Students (Asian, Australian, European, African and American Students)**
will be eligible for scholarship for the Course (Free Course Fee), on a competitive basis for 20 students.
